PHILOSOPHY OF SECONDARY EDUCATION

We believe that the senior high school should provide each student with the opportunity to develop practical, intellectual and social skills necessary for self-fulfilling and acceptable participation in society and for dealing with predictable life experiences, which may be encountered.

We believe that practical skills should develop occupational competencies and useful activities according to individual needs.

We believe that intellectual skill is the process of assimilating concepts whereby enlightened judgment and rational opinion may be developed.

We believe that social skill is the ability to participate with others in a harmonious and positive relationship.

We believe that self-fulfilling participation is that activity through which an individual experiences success, preserves individuality, enhances his self-image and cultivates aesthetic values.

We believe that acceptable participation is the performance of activities in relationship with others, respecting their rights and privileges.

Predictable life experiences are those conditions, which normally are encountered in obtaining sustenance and maintaining continuity of existence.
